Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 7, 1961, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Langlie-Mattix, Cary and Drinkard Pools on your Will Cary Lease located in Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, without separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the Langlie-Mattix, Cary and Drinkard Pools on the above-described Will Cary Lease without separately metering the production from each pool; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further however, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in either pool is capable of top allowable production.

Reference is made to your letter of the 10th instant regarding the proposed installation of a water pump at the [Illegible] well in the [Illegible] area of the [Illegible] field. The Commission has also determined that the proposed installation is in the public interest and that it is necessary for the conservation of the oil resources of the field.

This authorization is subject to the condition that you shall immediately notify the Commission of the operation of the pump and shall provide the Commission with the necessary data for the installation and operation of the pump. The Commission reserves the right to suspend or terminate this authorization at any time if it is determined that the proposed installation is not in the public interest or that it is not necessary for the conservation of the oil resources of the field.
