Administrative Order PC-180 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of Blinebry, Brinkard, Mare, and Brunson production on your Turner Lease, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-166 which authorizes the commingling of Brinkard and Blinebry production on your State Section 15 Lease is hereby amended to permit the commingling of production on the basis of periodic well tests.
