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AMENDMENT
Administrative Order PC-49

Reference is made to your letter dated January 27, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-49 to delete the requirement for separate measurement prior to commingling of Justis-Blinebry and Justis Tubb-Drinkard production on your C. E. Penny NCT-4 Lease, Langlie-Mattix, Justis-Blinebry, and Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pools, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the production from each of the aforesaid three pools has declined to marginal nature and that allocation to each of the pools would be on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-49 is hereby amended to delete the separate measurement requirement. Provided however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the three pools is capable of top allowable production.
