Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 13, 1961, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Drinkard, Tubb, Tubb Gas, and Blinbry Gas Pools on your Southland Royalty Company "A" Lease located in Sections 4 and 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the Drinkard, Tubb, Tubb Gas, and Blinbry Gas Pools on the above-described Southland Royalty Company "A" Lease after separately metering the production from each pool; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further however, that the Commission shall be notified when the commingling system is installed and that Commission approval shall be obtained at such time as common test facilities shall be utilized.
