Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated December 22, 1961, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Drinkard and Hare Oil Pools and the Blinsbry and Tubb Gas Pools on your Wants Lease located in Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from the Blinsbry and Tubb Gas Pools.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the Drinkard and Hare Oil Pools and the Blinsbry and Tubb Gas Pools on the above-described Wants Lease after separately metering the production from the Blinsbry and Tubb Gas Pools; provided however, that the Installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
