Amendment
Administrative Order PC-54

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of November 30, 1962, wherein you request that Administrative Order PC-54 be amended to include Blinebry oil production in the commingling authority contained in that order. It is our understanding that the Blinebry distillate, Tubb distillate, and Blinebry oil production would be separately metered prior to commingling and that the Drinkard and Hare production being marginal would be determined on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-54 is hereby amended to include the Blinebry oil zone production in the commingling authority. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in the Drinkard or Hare Pools becomes capable of top allowable production.
