AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-55

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated April 1, 1968, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-55 which order authorized the commingling of oil from the Drinkard and Blinebry Oil Pools and condensate from the Tubb Gas Pool, Eumont Gas Pool, and Blinebry Gas Pool on your State "C" Tract 12 Lease after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that the Eumont zone is no longer productive and that all wells in the other zones are of marginal nature and that you therefore propose to commingle, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-55 is hereby amended to delete the Eumont zone from the commingling authority and to delete the metering requirement from the other zones. Provided however, that you shall notify the Commission in the event any zone on this lease becomes capable of top allowable production.

Reference is made to your letter dated April 1, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order 10-55 which order authorized the Commission on Oil from the Alameda and Kinney Oil Fields and condensates from the Tubb Gas Field, Tubb Gas Pool, and Kinney Gas Pool. Your state has been 12 lease after separately stating the production from said pool. It is our understanding that the Kinney lease is no longer productive and that all wells in the Tubb area are of marginal nature and that you therefore propose to terminate the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order 10-55 is hereby amended to delete the Kinney lease from the remaining schedule and to delete the metering requirement from the other leases. Provided however, that you shall notify the Commission in the event any lease on this lease becomes available for possible production.
