Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of September 18, 1964, wherein you request authority to commingle Wantz Abo, Blinebry cil and Tubb gas distillate on your Roy Barton Lease located in the S/2 and NW/4 NE/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry oil production and using the subtraction method to determine the Wantz Abo and Tubb production. Allocation to each of these two latter pools would be accomplished by periodic well tests. It is our understanding that the Wantz Abo production is of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-66 dated March 1, 1962, which authorizes the commingling of oil production from the Wantz Abo Pool and distillate production from the Tubb Gas and Blinebry Gas Pools on the subject lease, is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the aforesaid production in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in the Wantz Abo Pool is capable of top allowable production.
