**AMENDMENT  
Administrative Order PC-69**

**Gentlemen:**

Reference is made to your letter of January 9, 1964, requesting an amendment to Administrative Order PC-69 to permit the commingling of Ellenburger, Fusselman, and McKee production on your New Mexico State "BM" Lease after separately metering the Fusselman production and determining the Ellenburger and McKee production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that the Ellenburger and McKee zones underlying said lease are both of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-69 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the three aforesaid pools in the manner above-described. Provided however, that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement of a non-reset counter on the meter.
