Administrative Order PC-69 of March 22, 1962 permits commingling of Ellenburger, Waddell, McKee, Fusselman, Drinkard and Blinbery production on our New Mexico State "BM" Lease, comprising the E/2 SE/4 of Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, North Justis Field, Lea County, New Mexico after separately metering the production from each zone.

We are at present commingling Ellenburger, Fusselman and McKee, metering only the Fusselman per amendment to Administrative Order PC-69 dated January 17, 1964.

We request permission to discontinue separately metering the Fusselman Zone since neither well is physically capable of producing top field allowable.
