Administrative Order PC-69 dated March 22, 1962 permits commingling of Ellenburger, Waddell, McKee, Fusselman, Drinkard, and Blinebry production on Humble's New Mexico "BM" State lease, after separately metering production from each zone. This lease comprises the E/2, SE/4, of Section 2, T-25-S, R-37-E, Justis North Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

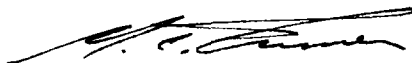
Amendment to Order PC-69 dated January 17, 1964 permitted us to commingle by metering only the Fusselman production and determining the remainder by means of the subtraction method.

Amendment to Order PC-69 dated September 4, 1964 permitted us to determine production from all producing zones on this lease by means of periodic well tests, due to marginal status of all wells. However, a work-over returned well No. 1 Fusselman to top allowable and separate metering facilities for the Fusselman zone were placed back in service immediately.

Since none of the wells on this lease are now physically capable of producing top allowable, we request that Administrative Order PC-69 again be amended to delete all zones from being separately metered, and that production be determined by periodic well tests. Required production data is attached.
