Administrative Order PC-73

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of February 25, 1963, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-73 to include the Penrose-Skelly production from your State "CK" Lease in Section 19, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in said commingling authority. It is our understanding that the Drinkard and Paddock production are presently separately metered and the Blinebry production determined by means of the subtraction method, and that with the new installation the Drinkard, Paddock, and Penrose-Skelly production will be separately metered and the Blinebry production will continue to be determined by the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
