Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated March 27, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the gas produced from the Cha Cha-Gallup Pool through the Hagood Well No. 29-G with the gas produced on the Hagood Lease from the Totah-Gallup Pool in Sections 20 and 30, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, the allocation of production to each pool to be made on the basis of Gas-Oil Ratio Tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the gas produced from the Cha Cha-Gallup Pool through the Hagood Well No. 29-G with the gas produced on the Hagood Lease from the Totah-Gallup Pool, the allocation of production to each pool to be made on the basis of Gas-Oil Ratio Tests; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
