Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 27, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Tubbs and Blinabry Gas Pools, Blinabry Oil Pool, Drinkard Oil Pool and Tubbs Oil Pool on your Southland Royalty Company "A" Lease in Sections 4 and 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NEPM, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease, in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
