Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 27, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Eunice Pool and an undesignated Blinshy oil pool underlying your Mayer B-4 Lease located in Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, NMM, Lea County, New Mexico, by metering the production from the Blinshy Pool and determining the Eunice production by means of subtraction.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease, in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
