Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 16, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Tubb-Brinkard, Devonian, Fusselman, McFee, and Ellenburger Pools, North Justis Field, on your G. L. Ervin "b" (NCT-2) Lease in the SE/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 18 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease, in the above-described manner.
