Reference is made to your letter of June 29, 1962, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-80, dated May 3, 1962, which authorized you to commingle the production from the Fubb-Drinkard, Devonian, Fusselman, McKee, and Ellenburger Pools, North Justis Field, underlying your G. L. Erwin "b" (NKT-2) Lease comprising the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you now have Waddell some production on this lease and that the previously considered sour crude Blinbry production has been reclassified as intermediate sweet crude, and that you therefore now desire to include the Waddell and Blinbry production with the aforementioned commingled some. Positive displacement meters will be installed on all some for measurement prior to commingling.

Administrative Order PC-80 is hereby amended to include the Waddell some and the Blinbry some in the commingling authority.
