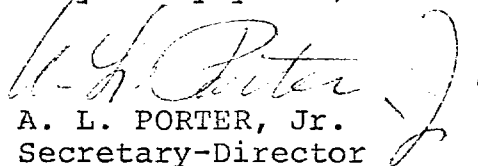
Amendment, Administrative Orders
PC-29, PC-63, PC-80, PC-81, PC-82,
PC-146, and PC-323

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your several recent letters requesting the amendment of the above-captioned administrative orders which authorized the commingling of production from various pools on various leases, with the requirement for metering of some or all of the production in each commingling installation.

From the data supplied, it is apparent that all of the subject production is now of marginal nature and you are therefore hereby authorized to commingle said production as before, except that allocation of production to each pool on each lease shall be on the basis of periodic well tests.
