**Administrative Order PC-84**

**Gentlemen:**

Reference is made to your application dated May 3, 1962, and to your letter of May 16, 1962, requesting administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Blinberry, Tubb-Drinkard, Maddell, McKee, Devonian, Fusselman, and Ellenburger zones of the North Justis Field on your State "A" Lease, located in Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, MHPM, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that all crudes covered in the subject application have been classified as sweet crudes and can thus be commingled in a common tank battery.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

Administrative Order PC-89, heretofore issued for certain zones underlying the subject lease, is hereby cancelled.
