Reference is made to your application dated May 3, 1962, and to your letter of May 16, 1962, requesting administrative approval of an exception to Mule 303 (a) of the Commission Mules and Regulations to pasmit the commissing of the production from the Blinebry, Tubb-Drinkard, Madell, Makee, Devenian, Pusselmen, and Ellenburger somes of the North Justis Field on your State RJ "A" Lease, located in Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, MMPM, Lea County, New Maxice, after separately metering the production from each pool.
