In support of our request for exception approval without notice and hearing to Rule 303 (a) to permit the commingling in common facilities of the commonly owned production from two or more common sources of supply. the following is submitted:

- 1. The oil production from each common source will be measured separately utilizing Floco meters. The BS&W content will be periodically determined by centrifugal testing procedures.
- 2. The Floco meters will be proved monthly in the existing 500 bbl. stock tanks.


The commercial value of the commingled production will be \$1,325 per year more than the sum of the production from each common source of supply.


