Reference is made to your application dated August 3, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the oil production from the Blinbry Oil Pool, Tubb Oil Pool, Drinkard Oil Pool and Warts-Abe Oil Pool and the liquid hydrocarbon production from the Tubb and Blinbry Gas Pools on your Southland Royalty "A" Lease located in Sections 4 and 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPN, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.
