Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 23, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the oil production from the Brunson, Drinkard and Hare Pools and the liquid hydrocarbon production from the Blinebry and Tubb Pools on your Hawk B-10 Lease located in section 10, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately measuring the Blinebry, Tubb and Hare production and allocating the production to the Brunson and the Drinkard Pools on the basis of quarterly tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; provided further, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in any pool is capable of top allowable production; and provided further, that the pneumatic interlocks on the two-way valves shall be so arranged that only one pair may be opened at a time.
