Gentlemen: Re: Revision of Administrative
Order PC-91

Administrative Order No. PC 91 dated August 13, 1962 granted permission to commingle oil from the Brunson, Drinkard and Hare Pools with metered production from the Tubb and Blinebry pools. Since that time we have developed top allowable Wantz Abo production by recompleting in that formation wells which formerly produced from the Hare Pool. We now wish to add this production to the commingled stream.

We attach the following Exhibits:

1. Revised plat showing wells as they are now completed.
2. Revised schematic showing the addition of facilities to meter Wantz Abo Crude prior to commingling.
3. Letter from Regional Oil and Gas Supervisor indicating his consent to the proposed commingling.

We should appreciate your reviewing the information submitted herewith and, if acceptable, entering an amendment to Order PC-91 authorizing the commingling of Wantz Abo production with the crudes now authorized by that order to be commingled on our Hawk B-10 Lease located in Section 10, Township 21S, Range 37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

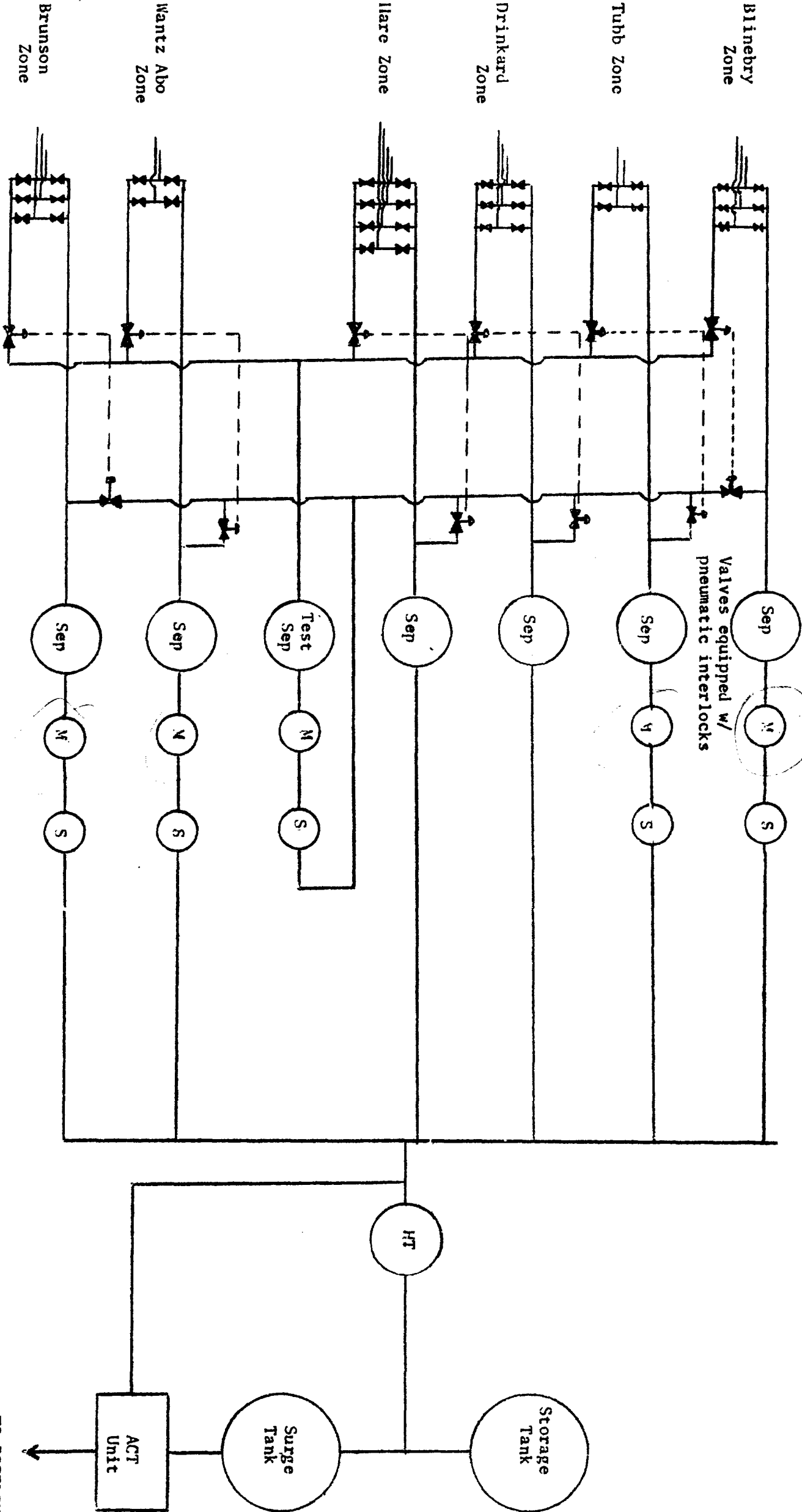

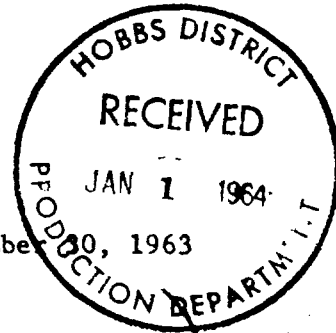
