Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 16, 1964, wherein you request that Administrative Order PC-96 be amended to delete the requirement for separate measurement of the production prior to commingling. This order authorises the commingling of Blinebry, Tubb-Drinkard, and Fusselman production on your C. C. Fristoe "B" (HCT-2) Lease, after separately metering the production from the Tubb-Drinkard and Fusselman mones and using the subtraction method for determining the Blinebry production.

It is our understanding that the production from all wells has declined to a marginal status and you wish therefore to now commingle on the basis of periodic well tests. Administrative Order PC-96 is hereby amended to permit the commingling in the aforesaid manner, provided that the well shall be tested quarterly and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the three aforesaid pools becomes capable of top allowable production.
