Gentlemen:

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Reference is made to your application dated September 5, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Terry-Blinebry, Drinkard, Brunson, Hare, and Wantz-Abo Oil Pools and the liquid hydrocarbon production from the Blinebry Gas Pool on your Lockhart B-11 Lease comprising the N/2 and SE/4 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from the Terry-Blinebry, Drinkard, and Wantz-Abo Oil Pools and the liquid hydrocarbon production from the Blinebry Gas Pool, and determining the combined Brunson and Hare Oil Pool production by means of the subtraction method. Allocation of individual Brunson and Hare production will be on the basis of six months' well tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; and provided further however that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such

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time as any well in either the Brunson or the Hare Oil Pools be-  
comes capable of top allowable production.
