

Application is herewith submitted for permission to commingle the crude oil production from the Yeso, Abo, Wolfcamp, Penn, and Devonian zones on Socony Mobil's State Bridges lease in the Vacuum Field area, Lea County, New Mexico. The location of the State Bridges lease is as follows: Lot 2 and SW/4 NE/4 and SE/4 Section 3, and NE/4 Section 10, and S/2 Section 11, and E/2 and SW/4 Section 12, and W/2 and NE/4 Section 13, all of Section 14, E/2 Section 15, N/2 and SE/4 Section 23, W/2 NW/4 and SE/4 NW/4 and SW/4 Section 24, NW/4 and N/2 NE/4 and SW/4 NE/4 Section 25, all of Section 26, and E/2 Section 27, all in T-17-S, R-34-E, and E/2 Section 25 and E/2 Section 34, T-16-S, R-34-E. Authorization for commingling is asked for under Rule 303. The proposed zones for commingling are presently being developed in Section 26, T-17-S, R-34-E.


