AMENDMENT  
Administrative Order PC-100

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated July 9, 1963, wherein you have requested that Administrative Order PC-100 be amended to include the Glorieta zone in the commingling authority granted by that order, which authorized the commingling of Abo, Blinbry, Wolfcamp, Pennsylvanian, and Devonian production in the Vacuum Field underlying your State Bridges Lease in Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

Administrative Order PC-100, dated October 4, 1962, and as amended by our letter of December 3, 1962, is hereby further amended to include the Glorieta zone, provided however, that the Glorieta production shall be separately metered prior to commingling and that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
