Gentlemen:

The present commingling order, PG-100, on Socony Mobil Oil Company's State Bridges Lease covers only Section 26, T-17-S, R-34-E. It is therefore requested that this order be amended to include the N/2 and the SE/4 of Section 23, the SW/4, the S/2 of the NW/4 and the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 24 and the E/2 of Section 27 all in T-17-S, R-37-E. All the acreage described above has common royalty and working interest and is contiguous.

Attached is a plat showing the acreage involved outlined in red and the wells which are to be commingled in the battery with color coding. Also attached is a schematic diagram of the commingling installation.



If you approve of the attached application, please forward such approval to our office here so that we may notify the NMOCC.



Gentlemen:

We have received your request to amend the present commingling order PC-100 which you have received from the Oil Conservation Commission, in which you have proposed to include the North Half and the Southeast Quarter of Section 23, and the Southwest Quarter, the South Half of the Northwest Quarter, and the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, and the East Half of Section 27, all in Township 17 South, Range 37 East.

We note that all the acreage described above belongs to one state beneficiary, that is, Common Schools. It is our opinion that your proposal as outlined in your application of February 4, 1966, fulfills our requirements for commingling. As a condition of this approval, we would like to ask that you notify us after the facilities have been completed but before they are put into operation in order that we might make an inspection at the site.

Therefore, the Commissioner of Public Lands hereby approves your proposal to commingle production from the above described acreage, reserving the right, however, to amend this approval at his discretion if the operation becomes contra to the best interests of the State of New Mexico.
