Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your revised application dated May 16, 1963, wherein you request authority to include the North Justis-Blinebry production from your State A-2 Lease in the commingling authority previously authorized by Administrative Order PC-101 for said lease which comprises the W/2 SE/4 of Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that under the proposed revised commingling installation, North Justis-Blinebry, undesignated Abo, North Justis Tubb-Drinkard, and Devonian production would be commingled after separately metering the production from all but the North Justis-Devonian Pool which production would be determined by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
