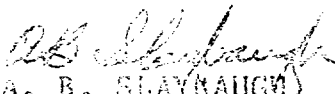
Dear Sir:

Your approval was granted October 4, 1962, under N.M.O.C.C. Administrative Order PC-101, to permit the commingling of the production from various North Justis pools on Continental Oil Company's State A-2 Lease comprising the W/2 SE/4 of Section 2, T 25S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. Since that application, the Devonian production has declined below top allowable.

Administrative Order No. MC-1286 approved multiple completion of our State A-2 Well No. 3 in Unit 0 of Section 2, T-25S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico, to produce oil from the Blinebry, Tubb-Drinkard and Abo formations in the North Justis Field. This well has been so completed and it is desired to commingle the Blinebry production with the other production already commingled from the Abo, Tubb-Drinkard and Devonian. Revised exhibits are attached together with letter of consent from the Commissioner of Public Lands.

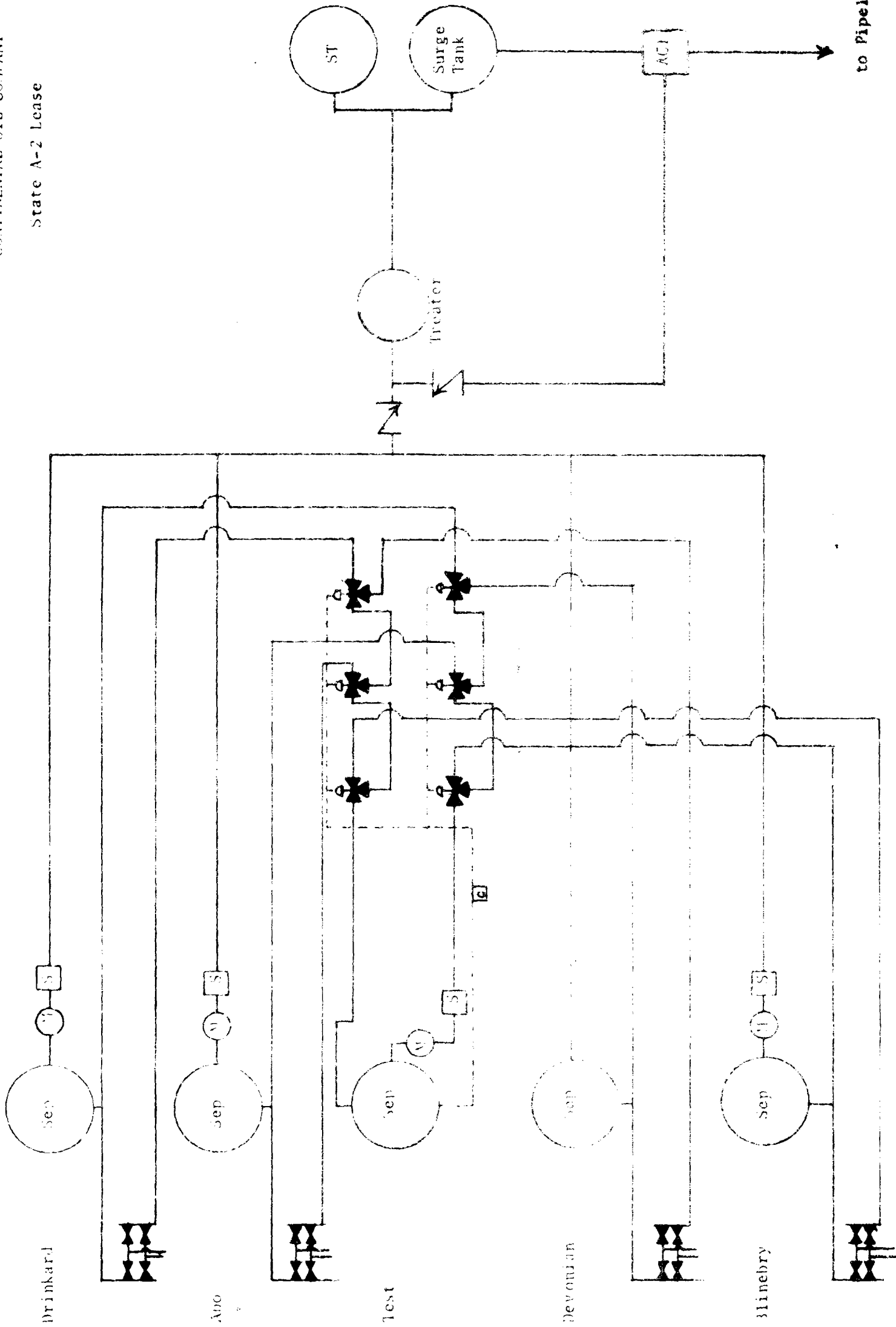
It is, therefore, requested that Administrative Order PC-101 be amended to permit commingling of liquid production from the North Justis Blinebry Pool with the above mentioned pools on the State A-2 Lease after separately metering production from each pool except the N. Justis Devonian, production from which will be determined by the subtraction method.

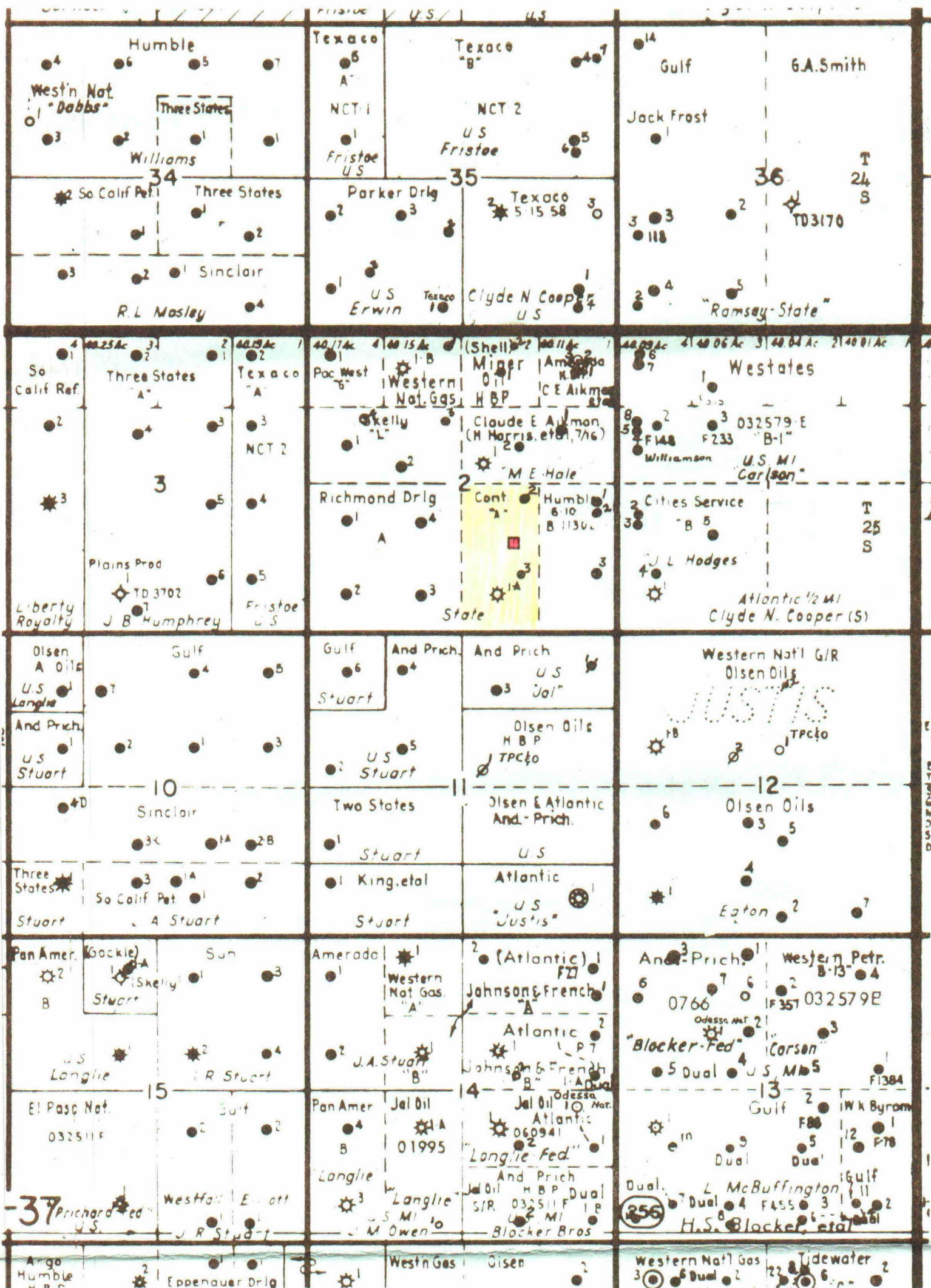

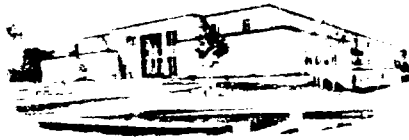

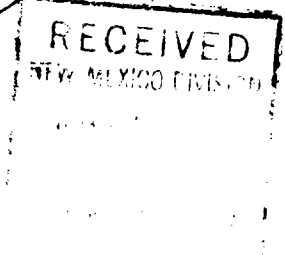
