Reference is made to your letter dated December 11, 1970, requesting the amendment of Administrative Order PC-101 which, as amended, presently authorizes the commingling of Blinebry, Abo, Devonian, and Tubb-Drinkard production on your State A-2 Lease allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.

It is our understanding that the Devonian and Abo production on said lease has now been abandoned and that you therefore propose to commingle Blinebry and Drinkard production only. Further, that the Blinebry is now capable of producing top allowable so that Blinebry production will be separately metered and Drinkard production determined by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-101 is hereby amended to authorize the commingling of Blinebry and Drinkard production on the subject lease as described above.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated January 11, 1970, requesting the amendment of Administrative Order 10-101 which, as amended, presently authorizes the commingling of Bittern, Duck, and Labrador-Brinard production in your State 2-5 lease allocating the production on the basis of relative well tests.

It is our understanding that the Bittern and the production on said lease has now been allocated on the basis of relative well tests propose to commingle Bittern and Labrador-Brinard production only. Further, that the Bittern is not capable of producing top allowable so that Bittern production will be separately metered and Brinard production determined by use of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order 10-101 is hereby amended to authorize the commingling of Bittern and Brinard production on the subject lease as described above.
