Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of September 26, 1962, wherein you request administrative approval of an exception to Commission Rule 303 (a) to permit commingling in common facilities of oil and gas produced from two separate common sources of supply and also administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit commingling the production from two separate leases in a common tank battery. It is our understanding that you desire to commingle Wolfcamp production from your Humble-State Lease comprising the N/2 NW/4 of Section 23, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and Pennsylvanian production from your State "L" Lease comprising the S/2 of the NW/4 of said Section 23, after separately metering the production from each lease and each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) and Rule 309 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools and said leases in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and

for non-reset counters on the meters.**
