Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your two letters of Movember 20, 1962, the first of which concerns commingling your State of New Mexico "M" Well No. 1, a Morth Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian producer, with your Humble State Lease production, and the second of which concorns commingling your John R. Thingson Well No. 1, a Morth Regley-Wolfcamp producer, with your Mumble State production. Commission previously by combination order PC-102 CTB-91 authorised the commingling of Welframp production from the Emphle State Lease with Pennsylvanian production from your State "L" Lease, after separately metering the production from each lease and each pool. It is our understanding from your present request that it is your intent to commingle Upper Jennsylvanian production from your State "H" Lease, Wolframp production from your Humble State Lease, Upper Pennsylvanian production from your State "L" Lease, and Wolfcamp production from your thempson Lease, all in Sections 22 and 23, Township 11 South, Range 23 East, Los County, New Marico.

Combination Administrative Order PC-102 CTB 91 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of production from the aforesaid pools and said leases in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the production from each pool and from each lease shall be metered separately prior to such commingling; and provided further, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the
