**AMENDMENT**  
**Administrative Order PC-110**

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated May 23, 1968, wherein you advise that all production going into the common tank battery authorized by Administrative Order PC-110 is now of marginal nature, and that you therefore wish to discontinue metering the production and to determine production by means of periodic well tests.

Administrative Order PC-110 is hereby amended to delete the metering requirement therefrom, provided that you shall continue to operate this installation in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well producing into this installation is capable of top allowable production.
