Amendment  
Administrative Order PC-111

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Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated May 20, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-111 to permit the commingling of Monument Grayburg-San Andres, Weir Blinobry, and Monument Tubb production on your O. J. Gillyully "B" Lease, comprising portions of Sections 22, 23, 27, 33, 34, and 35, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Monument Grayburg-San Andres and Weir Blinobry production and determining the Monument Tubb production by means of the subtraction method. Administrative Order PC-111 currently authorizes the commingling of the Monument Grayburg-San Andres and Monument Tubb production after separately metering the Grayburg-San Andres production and determining the Tubb production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, Administrative Order PC-111 is hereby amended and Pan American Petroleum Corporation is authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
