Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 21, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Wants-Abo, Drinkard, Tubb, Blinebry, and Terry Blinebry Pools on your Hawk B-3 Lease comprising Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 12, 15, and 16 and the N/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SE/4 of Section 3, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, and Lot 1 of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the production from the Drinkard, Tubb, Blinebry, and Wants-Abo wells will be allocated on the basis of periodic well tests inasmuch as there are no top allowable wells in these pools. Further, that the Terry Blinebry production will be measured by a suitable meter with non-reset counter and sampler prior to commingling inasmuch as some of the wells in said pool are penalized at high gas-oil ratios.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the

Reference is made to your application dated November 22, 1931, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (c) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Santa-Fe, Blinney, and Terry Blinney pools on your Santa-Fe-3 lease comprising Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 12, 13, and 14 and the N/2 S/4 and S/4 S/4 of Section 3, Township 21 North, Range 31 East, and Lot 1 of Section 4, Township 21 North, Range 31 East, Las Alamos County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the production from the Santa-Fe, Blinney, and Terry Blinney pools will be allocated to the Santa-Fe pool inasmuch as there are no top-surface wells in these pools. Further, that the Terry Blinney production will be measured by a suitable meter with non-reset control and separator prior to commingling inasmuch as some of the wells in said pool are产 high gas-oil ratios.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (d) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the Santa-Fe pool on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided, however, that the
