Reference is made to your application dated November 23, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the oil production from the Brinkard Oil Pool with the distillate production from the Blinebry and Tubb Gas Pools on your Hawk B-1 Lease comprising the E/2 SW/4 and SE/4 of Section 8 and the S/2 and E/2 NW/4 of Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and the Blinebry and Tubb distillate production from your Hawk B-1 Unit comprising the NW/4 of Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East. It is our understanding that the Tubb and Blinebry distillate production from the unit as well as the Tubb and Blinebry distillate production from the lease will be measured separately prior to commingling and that the Brinkard zone production will be determined by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.

Reference is made to your application dated November 21, 1952, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the oil production from the Grinkars oil pool with the distillate production from the Blinney and Trip Gas pools on your Newk 8-1 lease comprising the E1/2 NW1/4 and SW1/4 of Section 8 and the SW1/4 and E1/2 NW1/4 of Section 9, Township 21 North, Range 37 East, T11S, R37E, N21E, New Mexico, and the Blinney and Trip distillate production from your Newk 8-1 unit comprising the NW1/4 of Section 9, Township 21 North, Range 37 East. It is our understanding that the Trip and Blinney distillate production from the lease will be returned separately prior to commingling and that the Grinkars lease production will be determined by means of the subtraction method.

The authority vested in me under the provisions of Article 2, Section 1 of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for flow-test counters on the meters.
