Gentlemen:

Administrative Order PC-114 granted Continental Oil Company authority to commingle production on our Wantz Lease, Section 21, T-215, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico from the Paddock and Wantz Abo pools, provided production from the Paddock pool be metered. At the time Administrative Order PC-114 was granted some of the wells in the Paddock pool on the Wantz Lease were top allowable. The following tabulation of production from the Wantz Lease shows none of the wells are top allowable and the tests listed indicate they are not capable of producing top allowable. Therefore, Continental Oil Company respectfully requests that Administrative Order PC-114 be amended to eliminate the necessity of metering production from the individual pools on the Wantz Lease. Production will be allocated to each pool and well based on current Gas-Oil Ratio Surveys.
