Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 29, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Drinkard and Terry-Blinsbry oil pool production on your Naomi Keenum Lease comprising the N/2 SE/4 of Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after metering the Drinkard production and determining the Terry-Blinsbry production by means of the subtraction method.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
