Reference is made to your application dated September 19, 1962, wherein you request authority to commingle the distillate production from the Largo Spur Well No. 1, which well is completed in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool and the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool. We now have a letter of consent to such commingling from Mr. John A. Anderson, Regional Supervisor of the United States Geological Survey.

Radfern and Herd, Inc., is hereby authorized to commingle the Dakota and Gallup liquid production from the aforesaid well. It is our understanding that the production from each formation will be measured separately except when shipping oil which would be approximately two days per month. Production will be attributed to each zone on those days in accordance with periodic well tests.
