Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated January 30, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the production from the Glorieta, Blinebry, Wolfcamp, Pennsylvanian, and Devonian formations, Vacuum Field, on your State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-1) Lease comprising the S/2 of the N/2, SE/4 and S/2 SW/4 of section 36, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.
