AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-132

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 4, 1968, for an amendment to Administrative Order PC-132 which authorized the commingling of Blinebry and South Brunson-Ellenburger production from your Scarborough Estate Lease in Section 3, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. We are now in receipt of the 60-day production record supporting your request to delete the metering requirements of the subject order inasmuch as all production going into this battery is of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-132 is hereby amended to permit commingling as previously authorized except that the allocation of production shall be on the basis of periodic well tests. Please notify the Commission at such time as any well connected to the subject battery is capable of top allowable production.
