AMENDMENT
Administrative Order PC-135

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of June 14, 1963, wherein you advise that the commingling installation as authorized by Administrative Order PC-135 will not be utilized insofar as the Langlie-Mattix Pool is concerned. Said order authorized the commingling of Langlie-Mattix, Blinebry, and Tubb-Drinkard production on Getty Oil Company's State "G" Lease comprising the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Blinebry and Tubb-Drinkard production and determining the Langlie-Mattix production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that due to a sour crude differential, the Langlie-Mattix will not be commingled, but that the Blinebry and Tubb-Drinkard production will be commingled after separately metering the Blinebry production and determining Tubb-Drinkard production by means of the subtraction method.

Administrative Order PC-135 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of this production on said lease in the above-described manner.
