**AMENDMENT**

**Administrative Order PC-138**

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 4, 1968, for an amendment to Administrative Order PC-138 which authorized the commingling of Drinkard and Terry Blinebry production from your Nancy Stephens Lease in Section 24, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. We are now in receipt of the 60-day production record supporting your request to delete the metering requirement of the subject order inasmuch as all production going into this battery is of marginal nature.

Administrative Order PC-138 is hereby amended to permit commingling as previously authorized except that the allocation of production shall be on the basis of periodic well tests. Please notify the Commission at such time as any well connected to the subject battery is capable of top allowable production.
