AMENDMENT

Administrative Order PC-139

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of August 15, 1966, requesting an amendment to Administrative Order PC-139 dated May 10, 1963, which authorized the commingling of Blinebry and Paddock oil on your Mark Owen Lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 34, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the only Blinebry oil producer on this lease has been temporarily abandoned for some time and that you now desire to commingle Drinkard, Penrose Skelly and Paddock crude oil on the aforesaid lease, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests inasmuch as all production on the lease is of marginal nature.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall immediately notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.
