Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 24, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil production from the Skaggs-Glorieta, Skaggs-Drinkard, East Weir-Blinebry, and the Eumont Pools and the distillate production from the Eumont Pool on your Skaggs B-12 Lease comprising the NW/4 NE/4 and N/2 NW/4 of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Glorieta, Blinebry, and Drinkard production and allocating the Eumont oil and distillate production by means of the subtraction method and periodic tests.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities"; including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.

You are further requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission upon completion of this installation so that a field inspection may be made prior to putting the installation in operation.
