AMDNEMENT  
Administrative Order PC-146

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of August 21, 1963, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-146 to eliminate the separate test facilities which were included in your original plans for the construction of this commingling facility.

It is our understanding that you now contemplate shutting in all wells producing from a common zone during your Annual Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period except the well being tested in the Blinebry and Drinkard Pools and that the Devonian separator will be converted to a test separator at such time as it no longer economical to produce the Devonian section on your State of New Mexico "BZ" (NCT-10) Lease, North Justis Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

Texaco Inc. is hereby authorized to operate the subject commingling installation in the above-described manner, provided however, that in all other respects it shall be operated in accordance with the Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities.
