AMENDMENT
Administrative Order PC-147

O Gentlemen:

P Reference is made to your application for amendment of Administrative Order PC-147 which, as amended, authorizes the commingling of Glorieta, Blinebry, Abo, Wolfcamp, and Upper Pennsylvanian production from your State "F" Lease in Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool. It is our understanding that the designation of this lease has now been changed to State "BA" Lease and that you propose to commingle said production without metering, inasmuch as all wells in each pool on said lease have declined to marginal status.

Y Administrative Order PC-147, as amended, is hereby further amended to delete the metering requirement prior to commingling, provided that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well on this lease does again become capable of top allowable production.

Administrative Order No. 10-17

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for extension of Administrative Order 10-17 which, as amended, authorized the commingling of Shoshone, Blinman, and other oil properties in the Shoshone Pool. Your lease is located in the Shoshone Pool, Blinman, and other properties in the Shoshone Pool, New Mexico, and is currently metered to the production from the pool. It is our understanding that the designation of this lease has now been changed to State "oil lease" and that you propose to terminate this production without metering. It is our policy as all wells in each pool on an oil lease have a common marginal return.

Administrative Order 10-17, as amended, provides that any oil lease in the Shoshone Pool, New Mexico, which is not metered to the production from the pool, shall be deemed to be a "oil lease" and shall be subject to the provisions of Administrative Order 10-17, as amended. It is our policy that any well on an oil lease in the Shoshone Pool, New Mexico, shall be deemed to be a "oil lease" and shall be subject to the provisions of Administrative Order 10-17, as amended.
