AMENDMENT  
Administrative Order PC-163

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated July 25, 1969, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order PC-163, dated October 17, 1963, which authorizes the commingling of production from the Blinebry, Drinkard, Hare, and Tubb Oil Pools and condensate from the Blinebry Gas Pool on your Brunson Argo Lease in Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that you now have Tubb condensate on the subject lease and that you wish to include it in the commingling installation.

Administrative Order PC-163 is hereby amended to include Tubb condensate in the commingling installation authorized for your Brunson Argo Lease comprising the NE/4 of Section 9 and the NW/4 of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, provided that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in any of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PC-163  
EXCEPTION TO RULE 303(A)  
MOBIL OIL CORPORATION'S  
BRUNSON ARGO LEASE  
LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Gentlemen:

Administrative Order PC-163 dated October 17, 1963 granted Mobil Oil Corporation the authority to commingle production from the Blinebry, Drinkard, Hare and Tubb Oil Pools and condensate from the Blinebry Gas Pool on the Brunson Argo lease. Mobil respectfully requests that Order PC-163 be amended to include the commingling of condensate from the Tubb Gas Pool. Since all production from the aforesaid pools is of a marginal nature, it is requested that this production be allocated back to the zone from which it is produced by periodic well tests.

Mobil's Brunson Argo lease is described as the NE/4 Sec. 9 and the NW/4 of Sec. 10, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Please advise if additional information relative to this matter is desired.
